- Reduced fares are available for senior citizens (65+), persons with disabilities, and Medicare Cardholders. To be eligible, you must show one of the following: a valid MTA Senior/Disability photo ID card, or any valid government issued photo ID with proof of age, or a valid disability ID from another transit agency with any valid government issued photo ID, or a Medicare card with any valid government photo ID.
- MARC tickets and passes are not valid for travel on this line.

Additional Service

- The **MARC Penn Line** operates between Peryville, Aberdeen, Edgewood, Martin Airport, and Baltimore Penn Station, with continuing service to the BWI Airport Rail Station, New Carrollton, and Washington, D.C.
- Harford County Transportation Services** provides local bus service.
- Nos. 35 and 120** bus lines operate between White Marsh, Downtown Baltimore, and Johns Hopkins Hospital. The No. 120 operates during peak hours; the No. 35 operates during peak, midday, and evening hours as well as on Saturdays and Sundays.
- Nos. 410, 411, and 420** bus lines operate between Harford County and Downtown Baltimore during peak hours.

Days of Operation

The No. 425 line operates Monday through Saturday, Sundays, and holidays.

New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Periodically, the MTA will operate reduced schedules in an effort to accommodate demand for these buses is significant.

Trips marked with "S" denote the "Special Service Days, only those "S" will operate.

Standee Policy

- For the safety of our riders, the MTA discourages standees on all bus routes.
- If the last evening bus has a full seat, standees are not permitted.
- To accommodate passengers from a wheelchair, standees are not permitted.
- In emergency situations, such as severe weather, standees are not permitted.

Please note that a patron's need to board a bus by a certain time is not considered an emergency. Drivers are required to enforce boarding to additional passengers once the bus is full.

Weather & Emergency Plan

In the event that adverse weather conditions occur, the MTA will make announcements in the morning. Standee announcements will be made on route.

If the morning service does not run, the MTA will not operate.

Should the MTA be motivated by inclement weather to suspend service, the MTA will make announcements in the morning. Standee announcements will be made on route.

Commuters should understand that the MTA will generate e-notices and the Commuter Bus Service Update C changes in service occur.
